## ORDINANCE NO. 2411

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND. WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 10.52.220 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE IN ORDER TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF VEHICLES OVER THIRTY FEET IN LENGTH ON CITY STREETS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS FOR PERIODS IN EXCESS OF SIX HOURS AND TO AUTHORIZE IMPOUNDING OF THE VEHICLES IN VIOLATION THEREOF: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 10.52.220 of the Redmond Municipal Code prohibits the parking of trucks and combinations exceeding thirty feet in total length for in excess of six hours on any street in residential areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, vehicles other than trucks and combinations can exceed thirty feet in length and the City Council has determined that other such vehicles should be similarly regulated.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of Large Vehicles on Streets in Residential Areas.

RMC 10.52.220 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Length restrictions. In order to relieve traffic congestion and facilitate the orderly movement and safety of traffic and pedestrians, [AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 10.52.070] the stopping, standing and parking of [TRUCKS AND COMBINATIONS] vehicles (including but not limited to trucks, truck/trailer combinations, and buses) exceeding thirty feet in total length for in excess of six hours is [RESTRICTED AND] prohibited upon streets in residential areas of the City. For the purposes of this section, "residential areas" means those portions of the city which are zoned and used for single-family or multiple-family residential purposes. Whenever any vehicle is parked in violation of this section, the vehicle shall be deemed to constitute a hazard or obstruction to traffic and may be impounded pursuant to Chapter 46.55 RCW, as the same now exists or as hereafter amended.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any municipal code section amended hereby should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or the amended code section.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being the exercise of a power expressly granted to the City's legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect and be in full force five days after its passage and publication of a summary as provided by law.
