## ORDINANCE NO. 2228

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AMENDING SECTION 10.24.060 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE; ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT ON 188TH AVENUE NE BETWEEN REDMOND-FALL CITY ROAD/SR-202 AND NE UNION HILL ROAD; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, 188th Avenue N.E. is classified as a minor arterial street and currently carries traffic from Redmond-Fall City Road/SR-202 to N.E. 68th Street; and

WHEREAS, this portion of 188th Avenue N.E. currently operates under the prima facie speed limit of 25 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, in the future 188th Avenue N.E. will continue north to N.E. Union Hill Road; and

WHEREAS, based upon recent radar speed surveys, roadway geometry and design speed, accident records, sight distance, and surrounding land use, the City's Public Works Department has recommended that the speed limit along 188th Avenue N.E. between Redmond-Fall City Road/SR-202 and N.E. Union Hill Road be established at 35 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the recommendation and has determined to amend Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code accordingly; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Speed Limit on 188th Avenue N.E. between Redmond-Fall City

Road/SR-202 and N.E. Union Hill Road. The Schedule of Speed Limits in Section 10.24.060 of
the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to add a line regarding the speed limit on 188th

Avenue N.E. to read as follows:

State Route No./ City Street Designation	Traffic Direction	From	То	Maximum Speed
188th Avenue NE	Both ways	Redmond-Fall City Road/SR-202	N.E. Union Hill Road	35 mph

Section 2. <u>Duties of Public Works Department</u>. The Public Works Department shall post such signs and install such other traffic control devices as may be deemed appropriate and necessary to give notice of the speed limit established under Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being the exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title. The speed limits established by this ordinance shall be enforced upon the posting of such signs and installation of such traffic control devices as are required under Section 2 above.
