

ORDINANCE NO: 2242

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING THE 2005 FS PAY
PLAN FOR EMPLOYEES COVERED BY THE
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS
#2829 REPRESENTING THE FIRE SUPPORT UNIT.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond completed labor contract negotiations in 2003 with the Fire Fighters #2829 representing the Fire Support Unit; and,

WHEREAS, Pay Plan FS was established and put into effect the negotiated salary ranges agreed to through the collective bargaining process and adopted in 2003; and

WHEREAS, the salary ranges adopted by Ordinance No. 2191 have now been adjusted in accordance with the previously negotiated agreement with the Fire Support bargaining Unit; now therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pay Plan FS attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1 is hereby adjusted and the salary ranges increased by 2.57 percent effective January 1, 2005. The amended pay plan is incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.


