ORDINANCE NO: 2186

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING THE 2003 PC PAY PLAN FOR EMPLOYEES COVERED BY THE SEIU LOCAL #519 PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES REPRESENTING THE POLICE COMMANDERS

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond recently completed labor contract negotiations with the SEIU Local #519 representing the Police Commanders; and,

WHEREAS, Pay Plan PC will be established and put into effect the negotiated salary ranges agreed to through the collective bargaining process and adopted on December 2, 2003; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pay Plan PC attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1 is hereby adopted and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof consisting of the title, in the City's official newspaper.
