CITY OF REDMOND ORDINANCE NO. 2596

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CHANGING CROSS-REFERENCES IN THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE FROM THE REDMOND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GUIDE TO THE REDMOND ZONING CODE, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2011, the Redmond City Council enacted a series of ordinances adopting the Redmond Zoning Code as Title 21 of the Redmond Municipal Code (RMC), repealing the Redmond Community Development Guide, and moving certain provisions from the Redmond Community Development Guide into the RMC; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the transition to the Redmond Zoning Code, the Redmond City Council has determined that certain changes should be made to the references in the RMC.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is administrative in nature and shall not be codified.

Section 2. References.

A. Whenever any provision of the RMC in effect on the date of this ordinance refers to the Redmond Community

Development Guide, said reference is hereby amended to refer to the Redmond Zoning Code, RMC Title 21. Whenever any provision of the RMC refers to a specific section of the Redmond Community Development Guide, said reference is hereby amended to refer to the successor provision of the Redmond Zoning Code, RMC Title 21.

B. The codifier of the RMC is hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary reference changes in the RMC upon codification of the Redmond Zoning Code.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after publication of an approved summary consisting of the title, or as otherwise provided by law.
