 - Stalled private development, income, child poverty








Strong Community

 Bridge











Weathered Recession Well



Record share of regional employment Record number of licensed businesses – upward trend









Continued Effects of Recession

- Increase in child poverty, but following decreases
- 350+ residences + mixeduse components on hold in Downtown





 Slight drop in Redmond MHHI; continuing decrease countywide








Other Notable Findings

Parks & Recreation Program Enrollment by Age Group





■ More online services → more online customers




