1. **Bicycle and Walk Audit Update:** Thanks to the Healthy Eating and Active Living grant provided by Seattle and King County Public Health the City was able to perform its first ever community bicycle audit. The event was attended by about 20 cyclists who selected from two routes (Overlake & Downtown). One of which was basically the same route the Committee did for our July field trip. Staff will provide a brief summary of the event.
