

## I do not recall receiving City event notices, how do I confirm my address is correct?

The City of Redmond wants to ensure that all community members have the opportunity to remain informed regarding City events, projects, opportunities, and more. Occasionally, staff hear concerns that City-generated mail may not reach a property owner or occupant. If you are unsure whether you have received City event notices, please follow these steps to research your address and mail.

1. If you own property in Redmond, ensure that you receive information from the King County Assessor's office, including a tax bill or statement of assessed value. Note your property address listed in this material.
2. Compare the address described above to the address in each of the following:

3. If you find significant differences between the addresses, please send all of the information to the following e-mail addresses to indicate the differences:

4. If you did not find significant differences, you may be receiving notices. The frequency of mailing varies greatly and is often related to a specific City activity within close proximity to a property, street, or neighborhood. If no activity occurred in the recent past, it is possible that no distribution of material such as those described below occurred.
