III. DESCRIPTION

At the beginning of each budget process the Council is asked to approve a budget calendar that details the dates where tasks will occur up to and including budget adoption in late 2012. The attached budget calendar was reviewed by the Public Administration and Finance Committee on February 21 and at the Council Study Session on February 28, 2012.

The attached timeline was developed taking into consideration comments received last biennium regarding the need to concentrate on the quality of offers and performance measures and the desire to deliver a complete and accurate budget to the Council. This calendar differs somewhat from the past in that it has been front loaded with tasks to allow for ample time for all participants to concentrate on the quality of departmental offers. Other notable activities include gathering Redmond Community budget input through the Neighborhood Network Meetings, developing a budget that adheres to the City's six priorities as well as keeping Council informed of each step along the way.

Action is necessary soon, as some of the activities in the budget process are already underway.
