## CITY OF REDMOND RESOLUTION NO. 1375

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY WASHINGTON, REDMOND, TRANSFERING THE RESPONSIBILITIES ΟF THEBUSINESS TAX/ TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS ECONOMIC COMMITTEE TOTHEREDMOND DEVELOPMENT ALLIANCE OR ITS SUCCESSOR

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond recognizes the importance of an effective transportation system, that includes capital projects and effective management of travel demand and travel choices for maintaining community well-being and conducting commerce in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond promotes a strong multi-modal transportation system that offers real travel choices, with improved connections both within and through Redmond and between Redmond and the region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond approved the creation of a business tax on December 17, 1996, for the purpose of improving Redmond's transportation system and transportation demand management programs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council re-established the Business Tax/Transportation Improvements Advisory Committee on September 15, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Business Tax and Transportation Improvements
Advisory Committee is tasked with advising the City on the use
of revenues collected through the business tax; and

WHEREAS, the organizations that are a part of the Redmond Economic Development Alliance recognize the value of bringing clarity and commitment to working together under the concept of Redmond as a complete community that continues to invest in community-wide transportation, transportation demand management and transit solutions; and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Economic Development Alliance is transitioning to a new model and will be a part of a successor organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Transfer of Responsibility. The responsibilities of the City of Redmond Business Tax/
Transportation Improvements Advisory Committee, herein referred to as the Committee, are hereby transferred to the organizations known as the Redmond Economic Development Alliance, herein referred to as REDA, or its successor organization.

Section 2. Sunset of the Committee. The Committee will sunset as of June 1, 2012, and the responsibilities transferred to the REDA or its successor organization.

Section 3. Term of Committee Members. The terms of all existing Committee members will terminate at the sunset of the Committee on June 1, 2012.

Section 4. REDA as Advisory Body. As of June 1, 2012, REDA, or its successor organization, will act as the advisory body to the Mayor and Council on matters related to the disposition of the business tax.
